ANNUAL PARENTS/CARERS QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

In the Summer Term of 2017 Northway conducted its annual parent's questionnaire.

We had 43 responses out of 93 questionnaires we sent out - 46%

We wanted to find out how satisfied our parents are with the education we provide for their children and in which areas they feel we need to improve.

As can be seen the vast majority of responses were positive and confirm a high level of satisfaction. However it is clear that we need to focus on some key areas;

- The safety and well-being of the child is of paramount importance.
- The children's individual needs must continue to be met in all spheres of school life.
- Communication with and involvement of the parents in all aspects of their child's education and development needs to be improved.

So in order to improve the education and schooling we offer our children we have looked at strategies to address these issues.

- We regularly monitor the accidents and incidents book and respond to any identified trends or consistencies to decrease the likelihood of these incidents recurring.
- We have increased staffing levels in key areas to ensure greater supervision and awareness of the potential for incidents.
- We have introduced PLPs (Personal Learning Plans) which mirror the targets in the EHCPs and will ensure greater individualised teaching and learning.
- A school wide system for assessing small steps of progress within lessons is now in place to encourage more individualised academic progression.
- We have appointed a family liaison officer and a safeguarding officer to work with parents proactively and support them with issues of concern.
- We have set up training workshops to support parents in key areas of concern for them.
