Barnet Children's Integrated Therapy (Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational therapy and Physiotherapy)

Barnet Children's Integrated Therapy Team will be offering a blended service from April 2021 combining virtual services and face to face sessions where clinically indicated. We will continue to offer video and telephone consultations for Children and Young People referred to Occupational Therapy and

Physiotherapy Speech and Language Therapy accepted to the service. Where there is an identified clinical need indicated by a Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapist, Speech and Language Dysphagia Therapist then face-to-face intervention will be provided. Our therapists will follow current NHS guidance when working face to face around wearing of PPE, social distancing and guidance around mixing of bubbles within education settings.
